## **Emergencies**

Many support services, including the Office of the Dean of Students (541-346-3216), the University Health Center (541-346-2770), and the University Counseling and Testing Center (541-346-3227) provide emergency aid to students during regular office hours—8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

The University Counseling and Testing Center offers a crisis line staffed at all hours by mental health professionals, and the University Health Center offers a health nurse advice line when the center is closed (541-346-2770, then press 1). In addition, a 24-hour, round-the-clock crisis line is available for those seeking support after experiencing sexual violence (541-346-7233).
